Yvonne Jagtenberg (1967) studied at the specialist school of art after finishing her education in pedagogy, and first started working as a visual artist before she switched paths and started writing and illustrating children's books. Picture books to be precise, but to be enjoyed by people of all ages, and both fiction and non-fiction.


Her first picture book, *A Very Special Day*, was awarded and translated in several languages. This instant success continued over the years with the characters like Balottie, Percy and Wandert. Hers is not a mainstream style, but one of warm, vibrant colours, quirky but lovable characters and stories with a deeper message beneath the fun. Stories that appeal to both younger and older readers.

In 2002, she received the Charlotte Köhler Stipendium for her entire oeuvre. Yvonne Jagtenberg is also the winner of multiple Bronze, Silver and Gold Brushes and Pencils over the years, and it is worth noting that creators of both a Pencil (for authors) and Brushes (for illustrators) are a rare breed! In 2023, Yvonne Jagtenberg is the artist of the yearly picture book of the Childrens Book Week.


The Red Princess

The Red Princess has lived in the White Tower Palace all her life and no one has ever seen her. On her twelfth birthday, she will be presented to the people. But on her first day out, in a beautiful carriage, things go slightly differently.... Before anyone can even catch a glimpse of her, she is kidnapped by three highwaymen and a ransom must be paid by the people. The people are angry and then doubts begin to form among the crowds: what if it is all a conspiracy, and the Princess does not exist at all?
