






































The little farmer no one can help but love!



The master storyteller and renowned illustrator Thé Tjong-Khing presents his unique twist on sixteen fairy tales. These stories originate from all over the world and date back to ancient times, yet their enduring power remains unchanged. Meet a vibrant ensemble of lesser-known and diverse fairy tale characters, including a brahmin and a tiger from India, and sisters Lolla and Lilia from Italy. Thé Tjong-Khing (b.1933) is one of the most celebrated children's book makers in the Netherlands. He has created a substantial and intriguing body of work, and at 92 years old is not only still working every day, but is better at his craft than ever. Khing has received numerous awards for his work, including the illustrious Max Velthuijs Prize. His books, such as Where Is the Cake, Art with Cake, Picnic with Cake, Bosch, and Jake and the T.rex have been translated into various languages.






Hello! Yoo-hoo! Are you there? I have a question, he said. Do you happen to know who I am? What kind of animal am I? I don't know anything anymore...






